If you prefer not to go shopping for any of the items, we will take monetary donations and get the items requested for that specific month. Look for the box in foyer for monetary donations.


If you have questions on the food drive you may contact Linda Koch, Irma Donnor Delene Schmitz or Sandy Willett.

YOUTH GROUP COMMUNITY PROJECT!


