All the way back in 1997, Fred Rogers accepted an Emmy Award for Lifetime Achievement. In his



acceptance speech, Mr. Rogers had these words to say: "All of us have special ones who have loved us into being. Would you just take, along with me, ten seconds to think of the people who have helped you become who you are. Those who have cared about you and wanted what was best for you in life. Ten seconds of silence. I'll watch the time." The camera panned as daytime celebrities moved from awkward laughter to tears, confronted with the simple and incredible power of

those relationships which Christians call the cloud of witness – those through whom we have come to the present.

On November 24th, we will remember at Zion those witnesses – those saints – who have died in the past year. People who have been our friends, family, guides, mentors, confidants, companions, and more. Those who have "loved us into being."

We will do this for the same reason Mr. Rogers asked us those years ago. We are who we are through other people, and by remembering them and honoring their memories, we honor God who created and loved both them and us, making us fellowship with one another.

If there are those who you are remembering as part of the extended family of Zion Church, please let us know by Wed November 20. It will be our honor to share their name in worship, folded into the great cloud of witness to which we all belong. "I'll watch the time."

We will be using his book, *Finding Meaning - the Sixth Stage of Grief* as a part of a 6 week grief gathering beginning on Wednesday, November 13th. We will meet at the church from 6 - 7 p.m.

With the use of this resource, we will work together to come to understand your unique and personal experience with grief and begin to work through the loss, releasing the hurt and learning to grieve with more love than pain . . . because love never dies. And it is in that love where you can find meaning.

If you are interested in joining, please purchase your resource book and bring it with you each evening we meet. Books can be purchased through all sorts of outlets. The book title is *Finding Meaning: the Sixth Stage of Grief Workbook: Tools for Releasing Pain and Remembering with Love.* The author of the book is David Kessler. 
